From the 19<sup>th</sup> to the 21<sup>st</sup> of October in Cortona, Italy, the **Giangiaco­mo Feltrinelli Foundation**, in collaboration with the **City of Cortona** and the **Jura Gentium Center**, will host the 2007 edition of the Foundation's annual *Cortona Colloquium – War, Law and Global Order*.
